

SCOREKEEPER

1. Individual playing time does not have to be kept. Only the quarter(s) in which a player participates.
2. Shoot bonus free-throws (one plus one) on 7th team foul in each half. Shoot two bonus free-throws on 10th foul. Keep track of team fouls by half.
3. When a player scores his 20th (15th) point, notify the referee immediately by having the timekeeper sound the horn to stop play.
20 Points Individual Player Rule (4 and 5th Grade)
15 Points Individual Player Rule (2nd and 3rd Grade)
4. A team may not full court press while they maintain a lead of 20 (15 Points – 3rd Grade) or more points during the second half.
5. Complete the lineup card listing the last names, final score and individual points scored by each player.
Be sure “first and last name of players” are shown on card.
6. Completed lineup cards for all games are to be left at the scorer’s bench (2nd, 3rd, and 4th grades). 5th Grade Score Cards are to be taken by referee to West Middle School after the last game.
